

GOT YOUR SHOTS?

IS YOUR CHILD UP TO DATE WITH SCHOOL SHOTS FOR THIS UPCOMING SCHOOL YEAR?

The Wisconsin School Immunization Law requires:

Age/Grade	Number of Doses					
PreK(2-4yrs)	4 DTP/DTaP/DT	3 Polio	3 Hep B	1 MMR	1 Varicella	
K-5	4 DTP/DTaP/DT/Td	4 Polio	3 Hep B	2 MMR	2 Varicella	
6-12	4 DTP/DTaP/DT/Td	1Tdap	4 Polio	3 Hep B	2 MMR	2 Varicella

WHERE CAN I TAKE MY CHILD TO GET VACCINES (SHOTS) FOR SCHOOL?

- Call your child’s health care provider (clinic and/or doctor) if your child has health insurance coverage. You may need to check with your insurance provider for covered vaccines.
