#### **Tax Deductions**

Remember, tuition payments made before December 31 can be used for the State of Wisconsin tuition tax deduction for private school families on your 2019 income tax return.

The State of Wisconsin, (started in 2014 tax year), is going to allow parents to deduct private school tuition. Parents of private school students in Wisconsin could receive an income tax deduction of up to \$4,000 for tuition paid for each kindergarten through eighth grade student and up to \$10,000 per high school student. Only the amount paid after January 1, 2019, will qualify for the deduction. We highly recommend that families work with their tax advisor to determine benefits.

There is a separate schedule that needs to be filled out by the student's parents. This schedule can be obtained from the Wisconsin Dept. of Revenue website.

Tuition includes any amount paid by the claimant for a pupil's tuition to attend an eligible institution and mandatory book fees paid to the institution

Tuition does not include amounts paid with a voucher or any amounts paid as a separate charge for items such as: supplies, rentals of equipment, meals, transportation, personal use items such as uniforms or gym clothes, before or after school child care, extracurricular activities such as musical or athletic activity fees.

Only the person who claims the child as a dependent can use the deduction. For example, grandparents who pay tuition cannot take the deduction (unless of course they claim the child as a dependent).

A record of payments made can be found on your Sycamore account under "My Accounting" "Summary" "Tuition", made sure 2019 is selected and then "All".
