Parent Teacher Conferences

Next select a student and date, click one of the green squares to schedule that time. Click the 'Confirm' button on the 'Confirm Meeting' window. To show a list of your scheduled conferences click 'Summary'. To print out your schedule click 'Print'. If you feel you need more than the allotted time, please sign up for an additional time slot.

Tax Deductions

Tuition payments made before December 31 may be able to be used for the State of WI tuition tax deduction for private school families on your tax return. The State of WI, allows parents to deduct private school tuition. Parents of private school students in WI could receive an income tax deduction for tuition paid for each kindergarten through high school student. Only the amount paid between January 1 and December 31 will qualify for the deduction and only the amount that you personally paid. We highly recommend that families work with their tax advisor to determine benefits.






