2025-26 Re-Enrollment

Re-enrollment for families returning for the 2025-26 school year is now open. To help our planning we ask that re-enrollment take place by March 17. After March 17 the re-enrollment fee increases and we will open enrolment to new families. We cannot guarantee that seats will be available if you decide to reenroll at a later time.

Use the link:

https://sycamore.school/family/admissions/register?school_id=2297 or log into your Sycamore account and go to My School / Enrollment / Online Portal. At this time, you may also add students from your family who will be new to Bethlehem for the 2025-26 school year.

Remember that re-enrollment is not complete and your child's spot is not guaranteed until all steps are completed AND the enrollment fee has been paid.

Families who were in the School Choice program for the 2024-25 school year and are applying for again for the 2025-26 school year are not required to pay the enrollment fee but must still complete the online re-enrollment by March 17.

School Choice Enrollment

Enrollment for School Choice begins on February 3rd and closes on April 17. This is open to all incoming 4K, 5K, and 1st grade students and students who currently have a School Choice Voucher. Tax Deductions

Tuition payments made before December 31 may be able to be used for the State of WI tuition tax deduction for private school families on your tax return. The State of WI, allows parents to deduct private school tuition. Parents of private school students in WI could receive an income tax deduction for tuition paid for each kindergarten through high school student. Only the amount paid between January 1 and December 31 will qualify for the deduction and only the amount that you personally paid. We highly recommend that families work with their tax advisor to determine benefits.

A surcharge of \$75 per student is added for returning families who have not completed the re-enrollment and/or made their first tuition payment by August 1st.

Tuition pays for only a small part of the student's education at Bethlehem. The cost to educate a child is about \$9,800 per year. The congregation on average helps cover around 70% of the educational costs. Our tuition rates are very low to help families afford a quality Christian education. When you think of the hourly rate, a family pays about \$3.25 per hour while their child(ren) are in class or about \$23.00 a day for education and care. Thank you, Bethlehem Lutheran Church, for its support! If you have financial questions or concerns, please contact the school office. We do have programs that can help you with your tuition costs. 
