Julia Detlaff (11:27) missed the medal spot by 1 position finishing in 6th place overall.

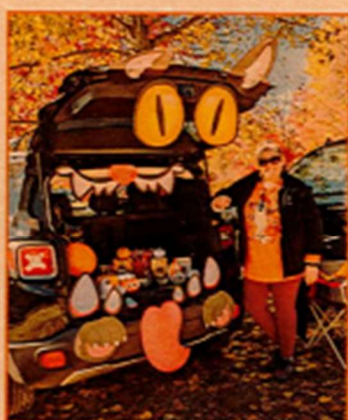
