Mr. Klug's Corner

Jamaica doesn't look the same after Hurricane Melissa showed its power and strength as it passed over the island nation. Storms like that can cause us to worry about our homes, our safety, and our loved ones who may be impacted. If you've ever lived through a powerful storm, you understand the fear and uncertainty that comes with it. In life, we face other kinds of storms too. Some are small and pass quickly, while others hit with the force of a hurricane. How will we be able to afford Christmas? What will the medical test results show? Why can't I seem to make friends? It's natural to worry about these things.

Yet, as Mr. Krueger reminded us in his chapel message this week, Jesus tells us plainly, "Do not worry." That's easier said than done, but God's Word gives us peace and perspective. In Matthew 6:25-34, Jesus reminds us that our heavenly Father knows what we need and will provide. Philippians 4:6-7 encourages us not to be anxious, but to bring everything to God in prayer and trust that His peace will guard our hearts.
