Dear Parent or Guardian:

This is to notify you that the Sheboygan County Division of Public Health has been receiving increased reports of confirmed pertussis cases within Sheboygan County. This letter will provide you with more information about pertussis and what you can do to help prevent the spread of this infection.

Please note that this notification is for your awareness only and does not mean your child has been exposed to pertussis at this time.

Pertussis (or whooping cough) is an infectious disease that affects the airways. The bacteria that cause pertussis are easily spread from person to person by coughing or sneezing. The pertussis cough can be severe and last for weeks or months, sometimes leading to coughing fits (paroxysms) or vomiting. Anyone can get pertussis, but it can be very dangerous for infants and people with weakened immune systems. Family members with pertussis, especially mothers, can spread pertussis to newborns.

## **Recommendations:**

1. Monitor your child for cough symptoms. If your child develops a cough:
  - Keep your child home from school and activities such as sports or play groups.
  - Contact your child's doctor as soon as possible
2. If your child has been diagnosed with pertussis by his/her doctor:
  - Tell the school that your child has been diagnosed with pertussis.
  - Unless your child has been coughing for 21 days or more, you should keep your child home from school and activities (such as sports or play groups) until your child has been on an appropriate antibiotic for five days to treat pertussis.
  - Ask your child's doctor for a note that states your child has pertussis.

Please make sure your family members are up-to-date with pertussis vaccinations. Pertussis vaccines are recommended and available for children, adolescents, and adults. Pertussis vaccines can be obtained at your local health care provider, your local pharmacy, or Lakeshore Community Health Care 920-783-6633 (without needing a medical exam).

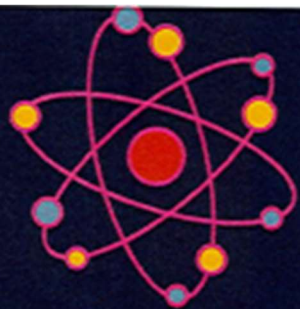
