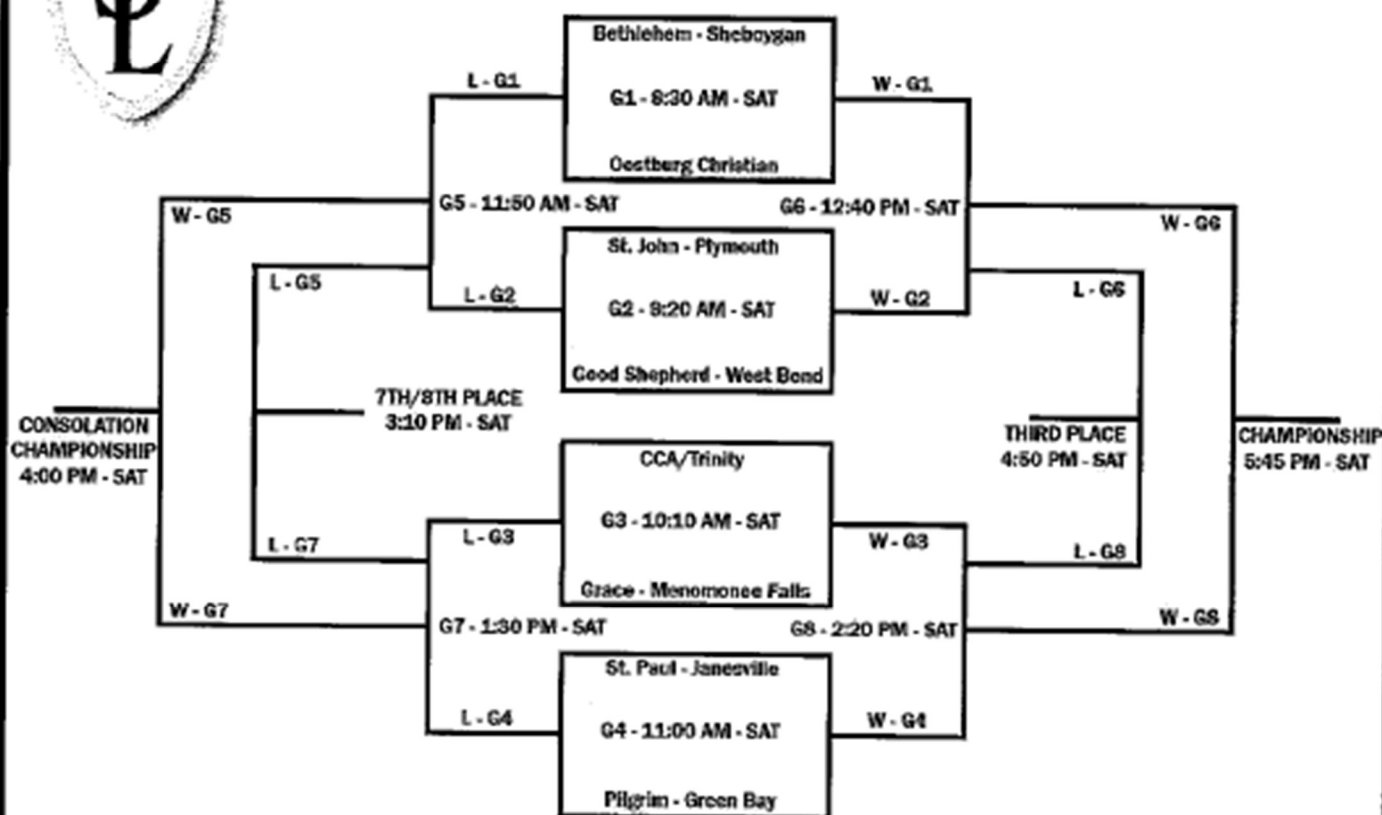

- Games will be played in 14 minute halves, with the clock stopping on all whistles.
- If a team has a 20 point lead after 9 minutes remaining in the second half, running clock will be used.
- Each team will be given 2 full timeouts for each half, with no carry-overs.
- **OVERTIME RULES** - Each team is allowed one full timeout with no carry-overs from the previous half. Overtime period will last 3 minutes. Additional overtimes will be 2 minutes each.
