Middle School Homework Policy Reminder (Gr. -8)

Homework will be provided for those students who have missed two or more days of school due to illness. Beginning on the third day, please call, or email, before noon requesting that homework be sent to the office. If your student is gone for one or two days, they can pick up their homework from their teachers when they return to school. They will then have one or two days to make up the work, depending on how many days they were absent.

We will get everything we can to the office, but, since 6th-8th graders have lockers, it will be up to you to get anything needed from the lockers, as not all teachers have access to them.
