Have You Completed Re-Enrollment for the 2026-27 School Year?

Enrollment for the 2025-26 is now available through your Sycamore account. All enrollment will be done electronically through [Sycamores Admission Page](#). No enrollment packets will be sent home. This is required of all students including those participating in the WPCP, WI Parental Choice Program. Your child is not enrolled for next year until this has been completed.

Enrollment for School Choice is also open to all incoming 4K, 5K and 1st Grade students. The application window for the second round of applicants will close on March 20. All students who currently have a School Choice Voucher will need to verify their information every year during enrollment. To apply or verify your information go to:

<https://sms.dpi.wi.gov/ChoiceParent/> Remember, if you are applying for School Choice you must still re-enroll through Sycamore. Your student will not be enrolled for next year or guaranteed a spot in class until this has been completed.


