Urgent Enrollment Reminder for 2026-27 School Year

If you will be returning to Bethlehem for the 2026-27 school year and have not yet completed enrollment through your Sycamore account, we encourage you to do so asap. Your student is not enrolled and a spot is not guaranteed for them until re-enrollment has been completed and the enrollment fee paid. All students who will attend Bethlehem for the 2026-27 school year, including those who have applied for WPCP vouchers need to complete the Sycamore re-enrollment.

Wisconsin Parental Choice Program Update

The third application window for the 2026-27 Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) is open May 1 – May 20. Students in grades 4K, KG and 1 are eligible to apply. Don't wait to enroll or re-enroll as the choice seats are now awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis and may not be available if you wait. Applying early gives your child the best chance at securing their seat for the 2026-27 school year.

Our last day of school will take place Friday, May 29. School will begin at the usual time and we will begin our closing service at approximately 8:30 am. All students in 3K-8 and parents are welcome to join us for the closing service. We will dismiss after the service at approximately 9:00 am.

Extended Care will be available before school, but there will be no Extended Care following dismissal.

When we dismiss, students, parents and families are invited to attend the school picnic at Kiwanis Park until 1:00 pm. Parents are responsible for transporting their children to and from the picnic as well as supervision during the picnic. If you will not be attending the picnic, please make sure you have supervision and transportation in place. Each student will receive tickets for a free sandwich and drink at the picnic and additional food and beverages will be available for purchase. In case of bad weather, we will dismiss after the closing service and there will be no picnic.
