Cross Country Team

The Badgers have been experiencing success from all their hard work at practice. We changed up our "hill" practice to make it more challenging and prepare us for the meet at Faith Haven. This course has several hills, some short steep hills and some hills that are not that steep but seem endless. Last year the 5th and 6th grade boys brought home the 1st place team trophy.

The Timbercat invite at Living Word was no match for the Bethlehem girls. 8th graders Olivia Flores (10:22.70) and Elanore Faucher (10:26.80) finished in 8th and 9th place overall earning both of them medals for their top 10 efforts! A solid run from 7th grader Julia Detlaff earned her a personal best time of 11:35, improving her time at this meet by 38 seconds from last year! The Boys were led by 8th grader Carson Grunewald (9:39.10) followed by Pat Stroede (9:57.30), Griffin Cyr (10:42.90), Eoin Irish (10:59.60) and Jacob Bult (11:13.60) rounding out the top 5 for the Badgers.

The Faith Haven Eagles Chase meet was where all the team's training was going to be tested. The Badgers showcased their talents with high quality performances on both the Girls and Boys teams. The Girls team gets the honors with top tier performances from all three runners, again. Elanore Faucher earned a medal, finishing in 3rd place overall with a time of 11:00.80, Olivia Flores finished 5th in 11:27.10, and Julia Detlaff finished 9th with a time of 12:00.90. The Boys top runner for the 5th and 6th grade was Jacob Bult, running a time of 11:20.20. The 7th and 8th grade Boys team was led by Pat Stroede, he used a strong kick at the end to give him the top spot for the Badgers. Pat has a personal best time of 10:16.40. Carson Grunewald was right on Pat's heels with his time of 10:16.50. Eoin Irish (11:14.60), Conrad Hasler (11:15.30), and Griffin Cyr (11:32.00) finished out the rest of the top 5 Badgers for this meet. 8th grader, Derek Senkbeil earned his personal best time at this meet, improving his time by over 2 minutes from last year.
