Welcome to Table Talk with Pastor Hanson! Pull up a chair and let's talk about what it means for Christians to live each day in Jesus' flock.

"Returning Home Daily"

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As the season of Pentecost continues, September's Gospel lessons (Luke 14–16) bring us face to face with Jesus' urgent call: repent, return, and live in the kingdom of God. In these chapters, our Lord tells us what it means to be His disciples—counting the cost (Luke 14:25–33), rejoicing in the lost being found (Luke 15), and warning us about the seriousness of ignoring God's Word and misusing His gifts (Luke 16).

Running through each of these Gospel readings is a consistent theme: life in God's kingdom is one of daily turning away from sin and daily returning home to Him. That's really what repentance is—not a one-time event, but a lifelong rhythm of confession and faith.

Martin Luther captured this beautifully in the Small Catechism when he asked, "What does such baptizing with water indicate?" His answer:

"It indicates that the Old Adam in us should by daily contrition and repentance be drowned and die with all sins and evil desires, and that a new man should daily emerge and arise to live before God in righteousness and purity forever."

Daily repentance means daily return to the Shepherd's flock, daily homecoming to the Father's embrace, daily rising again to live in the forgiveness Christ has won for us. And what a gift it is to begin and end each day with the assurance of our Baptism: we belong to Christ.

Luther also suggested a very simple, physical way of remembering our Baptism: **making the sign of the holy cross upon ourselves**. In the morning and in the evening, we begin with the invocation, "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen." And as we do, we make the sign of the cross to remind ourselves that we are the baptized children of God, marked by Christ's own cross, redeemed by His blood, and sealed by His Spirit.

Now, I know that for many of you this may feel "strange." Perhaps you were even told as children that "making the sign of the cross is a Catholic thing, and we Lutherans don't do that." But the truth is, **Luther himself encouraged this practice** as a simple, biblical way to remember the promises of God in Baptism. It's not "Catholic" or "Lutheran"—it's Christian. It's a way to put body and soul together in prayer, uniting our faith with our physical selves.

At first, yes, it might feel awkward. But like any habit of faith—prayer, Scripture reading, coming to worship—the more we practice, the more natural it becomes. And every time you make the sign of the cross, you are preaching to yourself: "I am baptized into Christ. His death is my death, His life is my life, His victory is my victory."

So this September, as we hear Jesus' call to discipleship, His parables of the lost being found, and His warnings about living carelessly apart from Him, I encourage you to take up this daily habit of repentance and remembrance. Start and end your days with the cross. Let it be for you a daily "return home," a daily renewal of your baptismal identity, a daily joy that you are part of God's flock.

Let's live each day as those who have been found by Christ, washed in His mercy, and called to walk in His kingdom.


UPCOMING LWML EVENT


