Packer Potluck

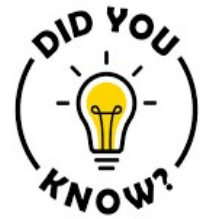
Join us in the Parish Activity Center on October 16th for a Packer Potluck.
